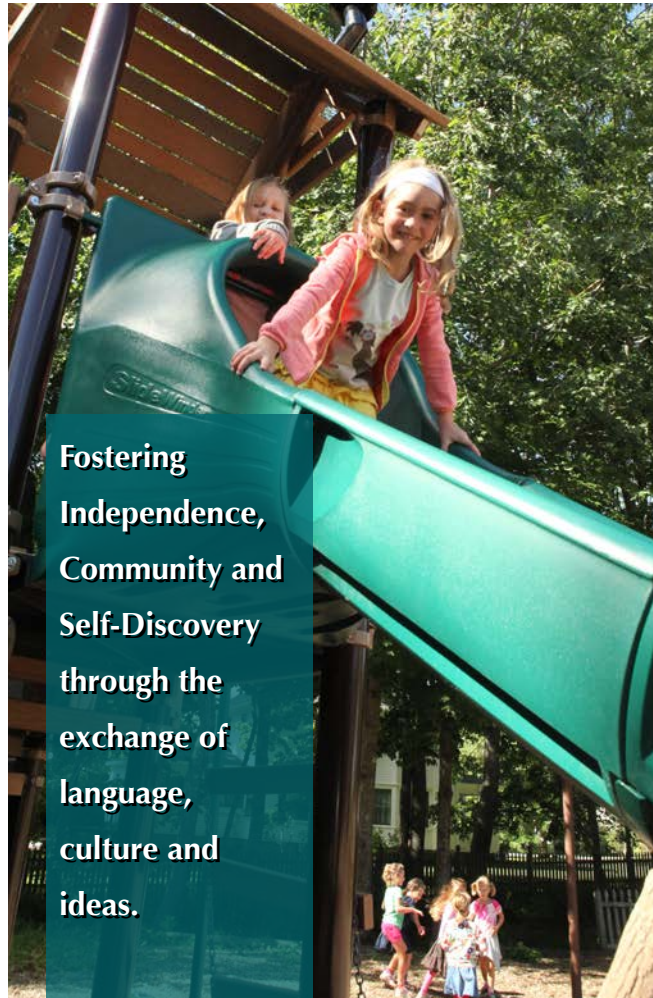
About Us

A unique and authentic learning environment, L'Ecole Française du Maine is the only French immersion school north of Boston. All academic subjects are taught in French by native speakers of the language, and our Preschool through Grade 6 programs follow the directives of both the Ministère de L'Éducation Nationale and the educational guidelines set by the State of Maine.

Entirely renovated and situated in the heart of the South Freeport fishing village, L'Ecole Française du Maine is located only 15 minutes north of Portland, Maine's largest city. How does Immersion work?

Children in immersion programs learn French very much the same way they have learned their first language: through observation, listening, repetition, and mimicking gestures and sounds. First, the children associate words with their meanings. Very shortly they repeat words, phrases and sentences, and eventually, they communicate in French.
